

Mixtape: Missed Connections

- Hunter K and Hunter R get into a fight at a convention causing a rift in the friend group
- Hunter K endeavors to make a mixtape trying to apologize when it wasn't really her fault
- She mails it but it's never clear whether or not Hunter R gets it
- Hunter K has to grapple with the reasons Hunter R wasn't actually a great friend and how she might have had a crush on her

Hunter K:

- ALIASES ONLINE: uglypunkprincess (tumblr), uglypunk (skype), catheadEccentric (pesterchum)
- Dad is a web developer on contract with the govt, mom is disabled and she has an autistic younger brother
- Her parents are fairly liberal, they struggle sometimes with affording food
- Wants to be a DJ
- She tends to seek validation wherever she can get it and it's hard for her to stand up to or confront people, she also thinks very little of herself and wants to make herself smaller via body language and baggy clothes

Hunter R:

- ALIAS ONLINE: believethedead (main tumblr), pancake-hater (callout tumblr), dickmahbutt666 (skype), ghostParamecia (Pesterchum)
- Divorced parents, lives with her mom who's a nurse and has a deadbeat dad who she actually really wants to approve of her
- Is a middle child; acts out because of this
- She cultivated a mean girl personality as a defense mechanism for being ignored and a way to get control where she feels she has none
- ** Has a history with Zoey but we're not sure the nature of it**

Zoey:

- ALIAS ONLINE: pancakeluvr94 (tumblr and skype), pancakePuppy on Pesterchum
- Lives with her single dad who's a freelance comic artist
- Has no siblings, dad is kind of friends with Hunter K's dad, they go to cons together sometimes
- Her dad is really relaxed and has a hands-off parenting style where Zoey makes a lot of her own mistakes and suffers consequences for it but isn't specifically punished
- Does artist alley at cons

Zack:

- His mom works in the same office as Hunter K's dad and they're good friends
- He's got an older brother who just went off to college
- His parents have liberal leanings but they're very pro-war in Iraq and his dad voted for Bush
- He doesn't get a lot of positive reinforcement at home or school, he mostly seeks out any attention he can get which is usually negative and has been expelled from 2 schools already

Just To Waste My Time With You (RED)

- The Hunters are introduced by Hunter K
- Hunter R is the only person who also knows what Homestuck is in Hunter K's art class and from there they become fast friends, talking on Skype and sharing Tumblr blogs
- They're planning on going to this convention together as Homestuck characters (Feferi and Vriska)
- They hang out a lot, making one of Hunter K's friends kinda jealous but Hunter K thinks they have a deep connection
- ** This is where the "if you were a boy it wouldn't be weird" line comes in**
- Hunter K starts working on the "Mixtape of The Con"
- Hunter K invites Zoey to lunch with her and Hunter R who has a really weird reaction to it
- Hunter R starts shirking hangouts with Hunter K where they work on their costumes together

Do You Have The Time To Listen To Me Whine? (TEAL)

- Hunter K starts talking to Zoey more often and they're planning on sleeping over for the con because they live closer and then meeting up with Hunter R
- Hunter R is really mad about this and unbeknownst to Hunter K starts trolling Zoey online
- Zoey starts getting all this harassment and bonds more with Hunter K
- Zoey opens up about having mental health issues with Hunter K who's been taking meds for depression a long time
- Zoey introduces Hunter K to the anime club

What's My Offense This Time? (BLUE)

- Hunter R starts blowing off Hunter K at school and she doesn't know why
- They're still friendly in classes but there's something off
- Hunter K brings up the convention to Hunter R who says she isn't going anymore
- Hunter R insults Hunter K in class and she gets the feeling they aren't friends anymore
- Hunter K's parents set up a movie "playdate" with Zack who is transferring to Hunter K's school and hasn't seen her since middle school
- It goes really well and she rekindles a crush she had when she was younger even if the "playdate" thing was embarrassing

Where Is Your Boy Tonight? (PINK)

- It's Junior Prom and Hunter K wants to see if Hunter R would like to come with Hunter K and her friend Zoey, but Hunter R says some bad things about Zoey that make Hunter K question whether or not they should be friends
- Hunter R says she'll go but only if Hunter K doesn't bring Zoey
- Hunter K brings Zoey AND Zack who is under the impression he was going with just Hunter K and is surprised by Zoey and kinda spends most of the time alone and upset
- This is Zack's last night of "freedom" before JROTC
- Hunter K almost admits to having a thing for him but is taken away from that by Hunter R framing Hunter K as having been harassing Zoey online
- Hunter K spends the rest of the night with Zack who's the only one who doesn't believe that she did it

Don't Count On Me (PURPLE)

- Hunter K and Zoey aren't seen around school together for a few weeks
- Hunter K comes to Zoey's house with a mixtape to apologize and prove it isn't her fault but Zoey isn't home because she went to the convention without her
- Around this time Zack is starting to change and it's hard for Hunter K to talk to him
- She goes back to Hunter R and confronts her on taking away her friends which doesn't really leave her with any answers but Hunter R makes her feel guilty for it as if she did something wrong
- Hunter K goes to the convention with her mixtape and heads to Zoey and her dad's booth, she apologizes for everything even though it's not her fault
- Zoey admits she knows it wasn't her but she doesn't like Hunter R and it was the only way to get her away from that friendship
- Hunter R is at the convention despite saying she couldn't go and when asked about it only says "I never said I wasn't going, just not with you"

American Idiot (GREEN)

- Zack has started not to have time to hang out with Zoey and Hunter K anymore because of JROTC
- He starts making weird comments about "terrorists" and espousing pro-gun views he never had before
- He's hardly recognizable anymore and when he comes over for dinner one night, he makes a homophobic comment which sets off Hunter K (where he references Hunter R and calls her a slur):
Zack: So how're things with your on-again off-again girlfriend? Also when did you decide you're a dyke?
Hunter K: Whatever I decide at least I'm not some bootlicking skinhead, drop dead

- His parents try to clear things up, they don't know where they came from, etc and Hunter K's parents are understanding but still side with their daughter
- He comes over again a few weeks later with an apology and they sit on the bed in Hunter K's room listening to a mixtape she made
- She confesses that she used to have this huge stupid crush on him and how that says a lot about her considering who he is now, he kisses her and she pushes him away saying it's way too late for that
- He asks if they can still be friends and she says she doesn't know yet
- Zack takes the mixtape home with him, it's called "You're An American Idiot"

So Long And Goodnight (LAVENDER)

- Hunter K confronts Hunter R over Skype about harassing Zoey and blaming her, but Hunter R doesn't really think she did anything wrong
- They basically cut off the friendship here
- Hunter K comes to Zoey's house to sleep over and asks about why Hunter R is being like this and Zoey's supportive but ultimately gives no answers
- Hunter K comes to school and goes to sit in her usual spot before Homeroom which is blocked by Amber's bags— she's already been replaced AND by someone she wanted to be friends with too
- Hunter K starts on a mixtape about how she feels about the whole thing

Thanks For The Memories (RED)

- A year later and Hunter K has started referring to herself as "Just Hunter"
- People have taken to calling her "Cunter" and "Fat Hunter" probably due to Hunter R who denies that
- It's graduation now and the only person who Hunter K is still talking to is Zoey
- Hunter K thinks on all the memories her and Hunter R shared back in highschool before junior year and is really upset about it
- She sends off her mixtape in the mail and she's not sure if Hunter R ever got it
- Hunter K decides that she's happy with Zoey who seems to accept her for who she is
- She gets a text from Zack asking if she's open to hang out even though they haven't talked and she says "Okay"
