Reassigning gender as a solution to gender imbalance and sexism in the military. Subject 7.

Abstract: Despite efforts to recruit more females to Earth Force, gender disparity remains extreme with only 18.2% of active service members identifying as female (Earth Force, 2057). Research shows that gender disparity contributes to a pervasive culture of sexism within the ranks (Collete, Harley, 2055). Thanks to advances in nanobot technology, it is now possible to transform any member physically into the opposite sex. Our study examines the feasibility of addressing Earth Force's sexual imbalance issues through the gender reassignment of male members. Our theory posits that some members becoming female while enjoying intensive, state of the art therapy will lead to a more sensitive and inclusive mindset among all service members.
