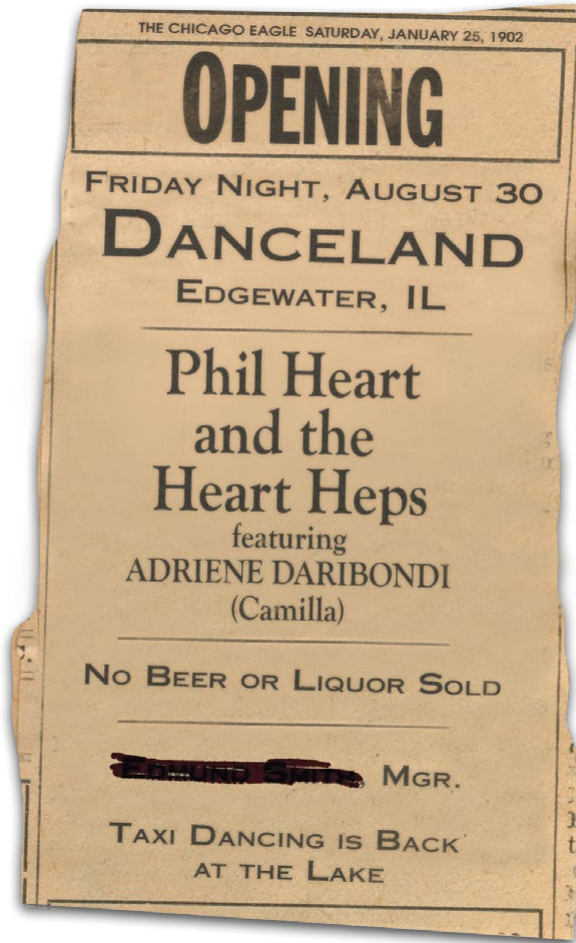

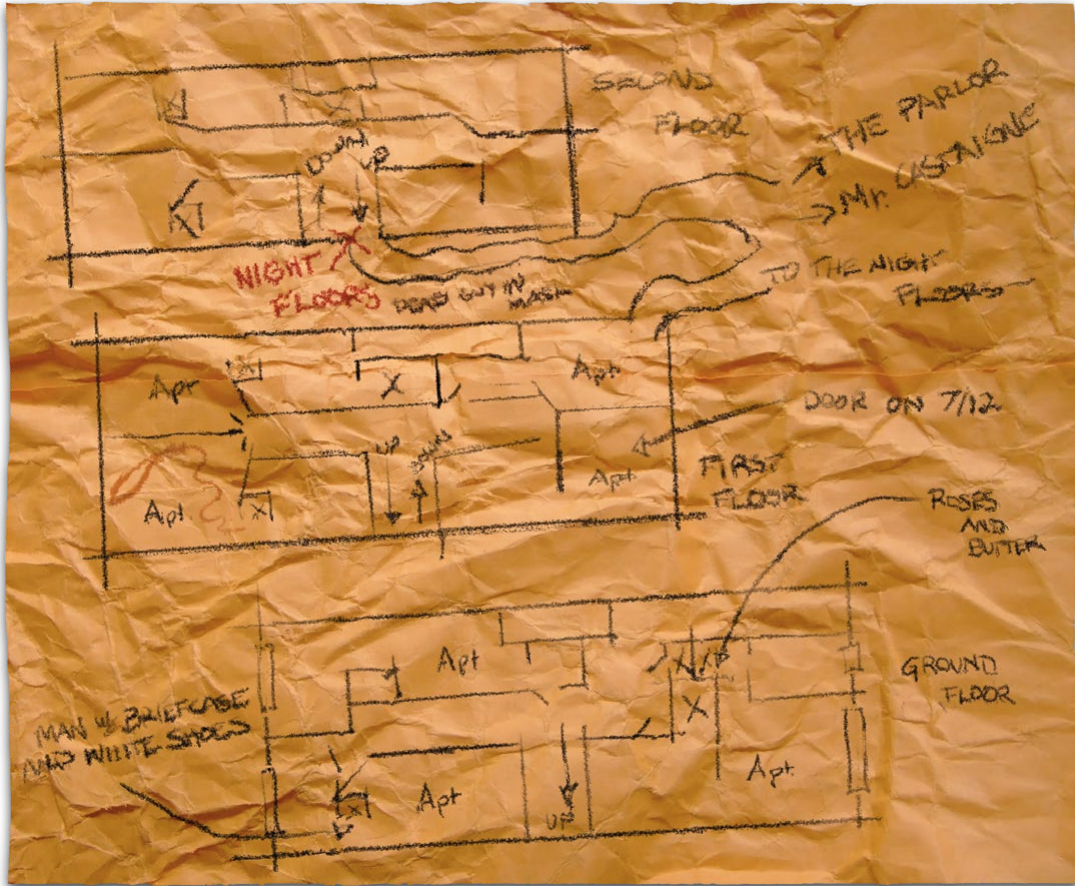
Macallistar floorplan (page 75)

(ENTER FEDERAL AGENTS)

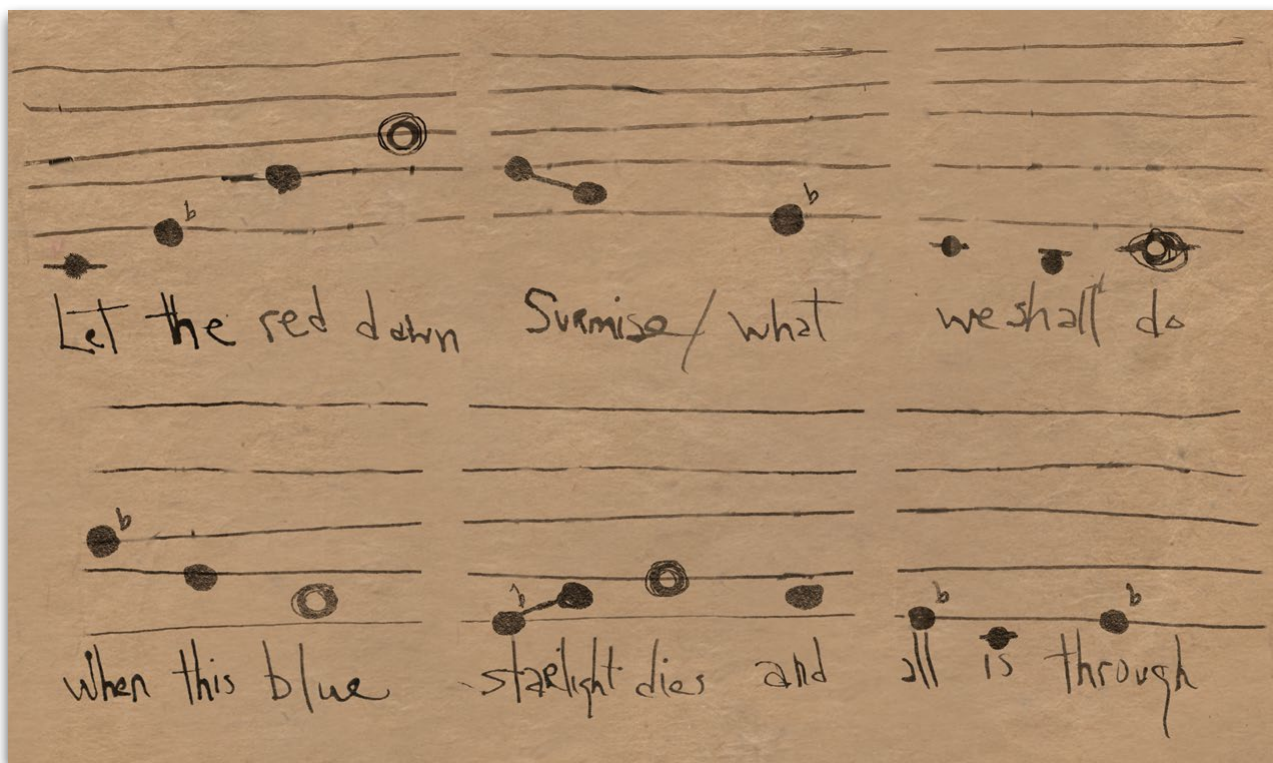
