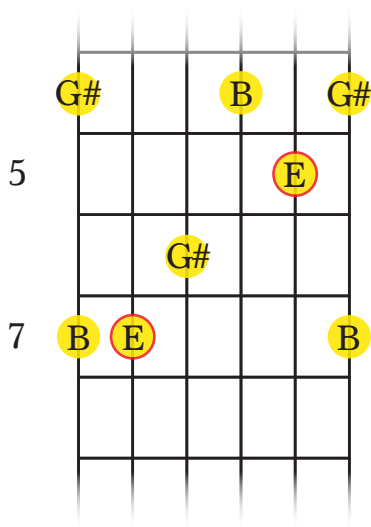


# CAGED Soloing | C Shape | I - IV Progression

Use the I IV Jam Track in E Major

This practice sheet tackles the Key of E Major, but you can apply this technique to any key using a C Shape as the I chord.

On the left, I've spelled out an E Major chord using a C Shape. In this case, the root notes (E) are on the 7th and 5th fret. On the right, I've mapped out the C Shape Pentatonic Scale in pink under the yellow C Shape A Major Chord.



Yellow = E Major Chord  
roots in red

Pink = E Major  
Pentatonic Scale

Green = E Major Scale
