Context: ever heard of the website http://rabb.it? Apparently it was a site that allowed multiple users to have watch parties for online content.

Apparently recently it was shut down after being bought out, however this "R\*b\*cca" user is dead set on it being linked to child abuse.

Anyway, she has a TON, and I mean A T O N of alternate accounts and will spam you endlessly if you mention it.

Furthermore, she will accuse you of supporting p\*dos if you block her because of it. It's just a never ending negative feedback loop.

ANYWAY, how does this tie to me?

Recently, someone made a thread on my subreddit about this and her subreddit (which has tons and tons of posts daily about this stuff from her many alternate accounts) r/StopR\*bbitsNewSites.

And since then, I've been subjected to this endless spam and borderline harassment by her. If you see her tweets, just block and do not engage for your own sake.

Introduction

Online harassment.

A source of mental anguish and a plague on ones happiness.

-show me stressed out-

Aside from stalking, I'd say that this is one of the worst things that can happen to someone online.

-show tweets-

The constant slander. The never-ending negativity by a vulture circling over your head, ready to strike when you decide you're sick of hiding.

-show me scared-

Yeah, I have an online harasser. And this is my story.

-intense music and title sequence-

Present Day

What a year.

As if prolonged quarantine due to a widespread unprecedented virus wasn't enough, I was infected with yet another. A different type of virus, that just won't go away.

If you head to any one of my tweets and look hard enough, you'll find her, and for obvious reasons, her name in this video is not actually her name.

-show tweet, then people saying "wait what?"-

The reputation damage that someone can cause with these claims are enough give anyone crippling anxiety, especially when people are unaware of the context of what's actually happening. It isn't just me, either. MamaMax, Mutahar, Loey Lane, and NightDocs have all fallen victim to this online plague, and have tried everything in the book to rid of it.

Law enforcement. FBI. Ignoring the situation. Fighting back. Releasing testimonies. Privating our accounts. and blocking and reporting. But she's still there, hiding beneath the "Show more Tweets" button, waiting and hoping for someone to notice her.

-show Twitter-

Why is she so hard to rid of, anyway? I mean honestly, if this is just one person going up against all of us, why even is this a big deal?

Hah, don't worry. We've been working behind the scenes, compiling testimonies, constructing dossiers, and noting every single detail that's happened. Some of the things she's done are enough to land anyone in jail, and her method of keeping her tirade alive is something that I'm having trouble wrapping my mind around. It's safe to say that I've never seen anything quite like it. And tonight we're going to explore it.

...So how did I get here? It's a question that I'm sure you all have and have had for quite some time now. Lemme take you back.

## II. Dawn of the Day it All Began

-SKIT: in rabbit costume, on laptop in dirty room on Facebook. Make comments on my Facebook page and zoom into them, making sure audience notices that they're directed at me. Cut to black.-

It was a February morning.

-show sun coming through window-

I was just waking up, sand still in my eyes, and I reached over to check my phone. Among everything else, I noticed I had a few Facebook comments. Not a big deal. I open them up to see what they're about and-

-boom, gradually glitch and "deafen" audience-

God dammit another ARG.

-delete, and get up, walk off shot-

If you're unaware, yes this is a common occurrence. One of the not-so-great things about covering Internet Mysteries is that people are compelled to create their own. And they can get.... Spammy. But I digress, I had things to do, and so I went on with my day as per usual.

-fade, then notification sound, pick up phone-

Again...? Wait is....this?

-show multiple examples of tweets from different accounts, and people questioning them-

That person, or people, person? From Facebook seems to be real convinced of something to do with me. The thing about the internet, and what's really getting to me about this, is the fact that when someone like this comes out with such loaded and heavy-handed claims, people are inclined to question it, and some, even if it's just one person, would be inclined to believe it. This is how rumors start. And I'm not about to be blamed for something I didn't do.

-click on Tweet, go to link, scroll through subreddit, go down the rabbit hole and portray that she has a ton of accounts, alts, and subreddits-

-camera shots alternating between "her" and myself-

Jesus Christ. What the f\*ck was I dragged into...? It appears that this is all stemming from *one* Reddit post about a website named Rabbit that was made to my subreddit. I'm not entirely sure why something so simple could cause such a wildfire for someone, but, hell at this point I hardly even know what Rabbit is and this post wasn't even made by me.

Sigh, I'll give it some time I just want this to go away. I don't need something like this wrecking my headspace.

-block and report, fade to immediate bombardment of notifications, "Two weeks later" intense music with camera over me looking downward, I'm stressing hard-

Alright, she won't let up and I see no end in sight. What to do...

-thinking, on one monitor have ADDRESS IT, on the other IGNORE IT, move camera back and forth-Sigh, here goes nothing...

-boom onto each post, then to black-

-wildfire-

Oh, now she's really, really mad.

From here on, I became target number one, and the next twenty four hours were nothin short of a hellish nightmare. Every single person that I publicly interacted with online became added to her growing list of targets that she openly touted on her many subreddits.

Scrolling through them is a non-sensical word-salad nightmare, filled with Tweets, my face, connections to Rabbit, and even threats. Yeah, for a while there, it got personal. Too personal.

You won this one, Amanda. You won this one.

Privating my Twitter until release of the next video so Amanda can hopefully get off my ass.

Normally I'd just leave it be but she's begun targeting you guys and my loved ones here and it doesn't sit right with me.

This stuff started about a month ago out of nowhere, and to be clear I have no idea who she is. I've never used Rabbit, nor do I have any intention on making a video on her. I just want this mess to stop.

Unfortunately others that have been harassed have reported her, but the authorities basically say they can't do anything about it.

It also should be noted that she began archiving my followers on http://reddit.com/r/StopRabbitsNewSites if you sort by new. Just a mess.

It's an unfortunate situation all around and I truly hope she gets help for this.

Things got quiet for a while. After a couple weeks under a private Twitter, she seemed to back off a bit. There were a couple of instances of rat accounts getting approved to follow me, but those didn't bother me too badly. I'll admit it was hard forcing myself not to check her subreddits every hour like I'd grown so accustomed to doing. Reading it was an addiction- an addiction that made me feel like absolute shit because there was nothing that I could do about what she was saying. While I was helpless other than blocking and reporting her spam, something about knowing what she was saying about me put me at this strange sense of ease, like I could somehow control it. Like the feeling that she wouldn't be able to blindside me again. She was in my sights, and was living in my head rent-free, but we all know situations like that are nothin but destructive.

Other than that though, relatively-things seemed to be lookin' up... finally.

-pause-

...but I am so naïve. I couldn't have been more wrong.

#### *III. The Amandavirus*

-snippet of interview from **Jym** "how did Amanda affect you, and how did it feel when she went after those that were in your video?"-

On the first of April 2020, one of my good friends NightDocs would release a collaborative video by the name of The Dark Side of That Chapter. While meant to be one massive joke toward our friend Mike, little did he know what it would turn into for him.

The upload featured a plethora of other creators along with myself all jumping in to give Mike some heat for the "bad" things he's done to us over the years, and it was all done in good fun. The thing was, I was a part of it...

And I was infected. If Amanda's the virus consuming my life, then this video was the catalyst that unknowingly spread it. Yeah, she started harassing everyone else too. Alex Bale, Dad, Inside a Mind, Nefarious TV, Swamp Dweller, Whang, and her favorite targets- Mutahar, MamaMax, NightDocs, and Loey Lane.

-interview with **Loey Lane**, "what was your first encounter with Amanda, and what went through your mind?"-

I'm sure each one of them could tell their arc of the story, and I'm pretty convinced that they'd all sound pretty similar to mine. Amanda enters your life without invitation, wreaks havoc, and becomes something that you just need to learn to live with. Police can't do anything, Twitter squashes her accounts, however more just keep popping up, blocking her doesn't do a damn thing, and interacting with her just makes it worse. This woman has so many accounts on so many different platforms that the

sheer scale of the operation she's running is so grandiose that it's incomprehensible. Sun up to sun down, she's on our case, making absolute damn sure that our lives are hell because she's convinced that we're all up to something nefarious.

One of the most ironic examples of this comes from one of her many Facebook accounts, where she's slandering Max, yes, MamaMax, the vigilante predator hunter, for being a pedophile *because* of his predator takedown video.

## -snippet of interview with Max, "how did her posts targeting you affect you mentally?"-

And the crazy thing is that *people believed it*. Unless these are bots, but these accounts go back pretty far, and we've even gone forth to get into contact with one of them. It's weird, though, because I've noticed a strange pattern with these people. They're nice to her. *Too* nice, and I highly doubt that they're oblivious to the torment she's caused people for years now.

Yeah, she's been doing this for years, but we'll get to that shortly.

# -Mutahar interview "what damage did she cause, emotionally or mentally, to you?-

Throughout April and May, her reign had spread to multiple fanbases within the Internet Mystery genre. While publicly, things might've seemed like business as usual, the actions we were taking behind the scenes proved otherwise. We began a hunt for information on this person, and realized that online discussion about her far preceded our involvement entirely.

Originating from problematic behavior in her previous profession, causing her to become banned from her community, to the eventual harassment of them and multiple others that would be tied to other communities, it's safe to say that this goes pretty deep.

I hope you have a snack handy, because we're about to go back.

Ladies and gentlemen, let's dive into a rabbit hole.

## IV. The Rabb.it Hole

# -SKIT: on webcam, turn head, cam girl-

It began with the advent of YouTube. The year was 2006.

A channel entered the digital space, uploading mostly nonsensical home movies involving dancing and family photos, and for what it's worth- people seemed to enjoy it.

These were run by our Amanda Pastrami, an avid fan of metal, deathcore, and hardcore punk music, as hinted at through the distinct visual style portrayed through many of her uploads. Over the years, she'd cycle through a plethora of usernames, all having to do with the word "core", "skulls", and "stormy" and variations of her real name.

#### **Suicide Girls**

Things get a bit hazy for the next decade or so, as she shifted from username to username across various websites, however in 2014, she'd eventually make her way to one named SuicideGirls.com where she'd end up amassing over 125 followers. For the better part of a year, she'd make periodic posts to the website, curating a community that appeared to be mostly supportive of her ...personality...

and style. Now, quick side note- remember how I mentioned that there are people on her Facebook that support her, even today, that *have* to have knowledge of her constant online harassment towards all of us? I'm not going to delve into how she met them, because I honestly don't know, but as we proceed just let the idea of those people marinate in your mind.

-pause-

Anyway, around 2015, she'd expand her presence into other content sharing websites. One of which being an early example of her many ventures into controversy.

-fade-

### YouKandy

It was around this time when we'd begin to observe the early stages of the structure and vernacular that she'd use to harass her many online victims. Interestingly enough, here, it was directed at a website by the name of YouKandy, an explicit content sharing domain that Amanda seems to have once frequented. The social structure of the website seemed to be based on a five-star system, where models would be rated based on the content and interaction that they provide to their fans. This would, however, prove to serve as the foundation of Amanda's controversial tirade against them, as she was increasingly convinced that there was some sort of conspiracy against her.

Today, the website's since gone out of business due to a lack of funds, however remnants discussing it are still online. Googling "YouKandy", interestingly spits out a screenshot from a website directing us to Amanda's predicament against them. This is only on the third row of the very first page of results, lending perspective into the actual online damage that this woman's able to do whenever she's pursuing someone on the internet.

Her website, fittingly, is simply titled "YouKandyTruth", and serves as a screenshot-filled Blogspot page of various DM's that she's compiled about her. Honestly, the blog post titles really tell you all you need to know here.

Allowing models to act like fools. Video proof of YouKandy refusing to send me proof I cheat and of model kcjane stalking me. Now YouKandy is going to call the cops on me. The tweet they had up then removed using my legal name. Epic fail by YouKandy and it's fake sites. YouKandy threatens me to tell sites lies about me. Unprofessional all-around 100%. Proof they steal money from men who go on the site.

Now, the actual turn of events that led up to this are unclear, however considering her present-day track record in regards to online drama, I'm led to believe that she formulated this situation around herself, curated a predicament about her being owed something, and ran with it in full force. As expected, she then proceeds to spam their email, Twitter, Facebook, website, what have you, until they give in and engage with her, giving her the heated response that she appears to thrive on.

In a response email to Amanda from YouKandy's moderation team from February of 2015, we can observe much of this logic in action:

This notice will stay on our site until all the nonsense stops and you remove your untrue blogs and stop tweeting lies. You were BANNED, and you were PAID IN FULL and NO ONE lost any money or tokens. And you know all this full well.

You started this. You can just as easily stop it. If not we will continue to display this notice and tweet it several times a day with your Twitter names if need be. We will also contact all the other sites you are currently on such as Extralunchmoney, Freelivefriends, mypornprofile, needlive, mygirlfund, etc, and

advise them of your actions, from one site to another we warn each other of users like you when we have to. YOUR CALL.

We will not be discussing this further. Feel free to post this on Twitter. -YKAdmin.

As you'd might expect, this interaction didn't do any favors for them, as Amanda would continue her pursuit no matter the outcome. An interesting tidbit I'd like to note is that soon after this, YouKandy, in a bizarre parallel to the actions happening now, would take their situation public, further issuing a warning to any unsuspecting passersby who might come into contact with her in the future:

Pagestormy, AKA Corestormy, Blissboundgirl, StormyRebel, Amanda Pastrami Reiferson,

A few models have reported that the above named person has been saying untruths about YouKandy and other users and models of the site. Even though we are reluctant to discuss individuals, we would however like to set the record straight by saying that-

As many of you are already aware, Pagestormy was BANNED from YouKandy for cheating in the weekly contest. She was also caught creating fake users and using those users to down-rate other models content on the site. All these "users" were also deleted and banned from the site.

It's since come to light that she's also been banned from several other sites for doing the same thing. When banned she was paid in FULL. We did not have to do this, however as an honest company with a very god reputation we paid her in full regardless of what she'd done. She was also provided with a full statement so she could check the amount was correct. One of her fake users, (or a very gullible follower), also claimed on Twitter that they were banned and lost tokens. We only ban users who break the rules to keep the site at a high standard for those that use it. None of the banned users lost money or tokens despite what they're saying on Twitter.

Unfortunately, since this was one of the many screenshots from Amanda's website, the rest of the message is cropped out.

There are two things in this bulletin that I'd like to highlight, though – She was also caught creating fake users and using those users to down-rate other model's content on the site. And one of her fake users (or a very gullible follower) also claimed on Twitter that they were banned and lost tokens.

This is notable since on her present-day Facebook page, people unconditionally support her. This has led me to believe that, much like YouKandy's claimed, maybe these are all alternate accounts made to artificially boost her numbers and make her appear more relevant than she is? Either that, or perhaps her Facebook audience, full of people showering her with hugs, support, and positivity, are runoffs from her time spent SuicideGirls, YouKandy, and the many other websites she's frequented in the past.

To test this theory, my friend NightDocs actually reached out to one of them via DM in hopes of gathering more information about her, and it's safe to say that the conversation speaks for itself.

On the XXXX of XXXX, 2020, he'd reach out to a XXXXX, asking the following:

# -Play out conversation.-

Now, while the quantity of Amanda's online footprints and interactions prove to be substantial; ironically, this would appear to serve as the catalyst for her descent into madness. To illustrate my point, lemme finally redirect your attention to a niche little website by the name of Rabbit.

-nostalgia skit-

The video-streaming domain allowed users to watch content online together with a live chat off to the side, and it's an idea that's been mimicked numerous times by various other hosts over the years.

Unfortunately, Rabbit had a relatively short lifespan, only having been online from roughly 2013 to 2019, however it's eventual demise was something that wasn't without controversy.

Like we hinted at prior, Amanda was and is absolutely convinced that *she* is the sole reason that the website went offline. But was it? I got into contact with a few people that were there when this was all happening, SlenderSnake, CometO707, PlusReed, Brock, Horror, and FullVengeance and feel that I've gotten the rough gist of what played out in mid-2019. And it goes a little somethin' like this:

In 2018, Amanda Pastrami eventually stumbled her way into Rabb.it, where both her and her child would watch videos in their spare time. Over the course of the next few months, Amanda's son, who we'll call Tyler, seemed to enjoy joining a particular user's room named *oChris*, who primarily hosted late night cartoons and Gordon Ramsey cooking shows.

It was noted by some that oChris was a father, and would allow children to watch his streams with him. After eventually discovering that Tyler was a regular of oChris's Rabb.it room, she began targeting and accusing him of being a pedophile. As you'd might expect- this wasn't pretty, as every single waking moment of Amanda's day was dedicated to ensuring that his online interactions were nothing short of miserable.

However it didn't go quite to plan, as oChris retaliated in full-force, beginning his deep dive into her online past. Once he discovered her prior profiles on various cam sites, along with her track record of sustained online harassment, he took it public in hopes of discrediting her entirely.

In this screen recording made by Amanda, titled, *ochris kitchen nightmare rabbit protects stalker*, we can observe their interactions exemplifying this:

O: If you delete me off your friends list again I'm not re-adding you.

R: whatever

0:?

R: or add me, yeah fucked up

O: what

R: I tried to add you and come in your room

O: so what? How many times are you gonna cry wolf?

R: whatever forget it

O: grow the fuck up. You don't run me.

R: me grow up okay

O: you couldn't pay me to be your friend at this point

R: I'm not going to fight with you. Okay bye.

O: Rabbit staff hates you. Take your screenshots of nothing and piss off.

This screen recording is one of tons that she's created over the years, as her method of compiling evidence involves gathering screenshots and uploading videos, most of which initially appear to be out of context and nonsensical until you dig up the backstory.

From here onward, this is where the various themes of her ramblings would play out, as Rabb.it never actually did anything about oChris since they claimed that he wasn't breaking any rules. Since Amanda was constantly harassing him, though, she was found to be in violation of TOS, resulting in her account, and all of her alts that would follow, to be banned. I'm led to believe that her vendetta against oChris, combined with the fact that Rabb.it staff simply didn't take her side on the issue had birthed a wider grudge against the platform entirely. Since this was the case, if you are or were, at all, In any form or fashion, connected to Rabbit, then you're complicit in siding with a website that sided with oChris, someone that Amanda was dead-set on believing to be a predator. With that in mind, as we know by this point, since someone made a post about Rabbit to the Nexpo subreddit, then Nexpo must be associated with Rabbit, and by proxy, a supporter of oChris, right? Well, no. I'm not. ...Yeah, that's why I'm tied up in all of this.

#### -pause-

But enough about me. What about her prior victims? Like I said earlier, I got into contact with a few users that were there at the time, including one of her long-time victims, Comet0707. Unfortunately, she's been dealing with Amanda's harassment for years now, and it even dates back to when she was a minor herself.

#### -Comet interview-

By 2019, Rabbit shuttered it's doors due to a lack of continued funding. Comet and SlenderSnake would continue running the official Rabbit subreddit along with another, named r/RabbitRefugees in hopes of keeping the community alive and connected, however it came at a cost.

After hearing about what Amanda did to her, myself, NightDocs, and all of the other YouTubers that were dealing with her had realized that this had far outgrown harassment and bullying. Amanda distributed CP to a minor, and action needed to be taken as soon as possible.

We reached out to a private investigator, her ISP, a lawyer, and NightDocs and Comet even contacted the FBI for a report.

# -play snippers of interview-

As you could see, most of the call seemed mostly productive. I was initially given the sense that we'd get some sort of ball rolling on this, however the ending shot those hopes down entirely. I don't know what it is but something about the way they rapidly wrapped the call up didn't exactly instill me with the feeling of optimism, however I could be wrong who knows. Perhaps we'll get a followup in a few months or a year and we can finally put this long-running issue to rest.

It truly is a strange feeling acquiring an online harasser. This type of phenomenon can materialize when you least expect it and persist for years. In my personal experience, though, you all have been incredibly supportive and understanding of what we've been dealing with, and for that I thank you so so much. To those that have helped report her, that have reached out to me in support, and that have backed me up, you are a rockstar and I'm so grateful for your help. Together, I know we got a handle on this.

Moving forward though, I implore you *not* to interact with this woman. Do not harass her. Do not engage with her. Do not reply to her replies to me. Simply block, report, and continue on with your day. She's caused myself and many others many nights of torment, and the last thing I want is to pass that off to you. If we all coordinate this properly, then we can keep her antics at bay, and hopefully, *finally* have her realize that she's been chasing the wrong people for years.

# Closing Remarks

And now we're here. In present day, October of 2020 and *still* dealing with the plague that's consumed most of our year. And you know what? I think at her core, her hearts in the right place. We have common ground, with a raging disgust for predators that exploit children that have not a clue of the dangers that they're getting themselves into.

The main issue I have with her is how she's handling it, because it's so, so wrong and misguided.

When you lure in predators, it's a tricky game. A slow-burning novella that ultimately results in the eversatisfying, but equally repulsive and disturbing revelation that while you've caught one, you know there are more out there.

But she's chasing the wrong people. We're on the same team, but she doesn't get that because she's so laser focused on her belief that if anything goes even as far as to utter a mention of the word "rabbit", then you're automatically connected to the website, and by proxy, associated with someone that she convinced herself of believing to be a predator. Because of that, apparently myself, Mutahar, Loey Lane, NightDocs, MamaMax, and all of our fans, you guys, are looped into this group, but, we all know that's not the case.

If there *is* one thing I've learned in this experience, though- it's that the widespread exploitation of children on both the internet and in real-life is an ever-growing issue that's much larger than I ever could've imagined, and KidsChat wasn't even close to being the only one with people like that on it. This issue is rooted so much deeper and has spread so far that exposing every place like this is a task nothing short of daunting. But this is where we rise to the challenge, because we sure as hell can try. So thank you for opening my eyes, Amanda. We'll take it from here.
