JLK missed a Meathook trigger when Voxy's Enduring Angel died. Would have brought him to 8 life and Xolo KO'd him for exactly 7.

-How much did this matter?

MIDROLL POINT

VOTING RIGHTS (AND WRONGS)

Selvala's Stampede. Was it the correct choice? Would you vote that way again?

- -Let's ask Xolo: *PLAY CLIP*
- -Ok what does Voxy think *PLAY CLIP*

XOLO POLITICS:

Xolo was a very political this game. (talk about Xolo being a political player)
