This exercise is a free for all! In the video lesson, I give a few ideas for how you might come up with your own sequence of A Major, D Major and E Major Triads. Remember, the goal here is not to make a masterpiece or even a finished painting. Think of this like a musical sketch book. Sit down with the supplied scratch paper and plot out your own sequences. Keep them simple. It's probably a better goal to spend an hour trying out three easy sequences than to spend a day working on one difficult sequence.
