
Standard Tuning Slide Guitar Cheat Sheet


Playing chords with a slide is tricky because you can only play them if each chord tone is on the same fret.

In standard EADGBE tuning, you're stuck with a set of triads like the ones shown to the right, in the key of C Major:

Triads in C Major

I C CEG
ii Dm DFA
iii Em EGB
IV F FAC
V G GBD
vi Am ACE
vii° B° BDF





Here is a set of chords in the Key of E Minor.

This set includes melodic minor chord IV and V as well.

Triads in E Minor
