

# Standard Tuning Slide Guitar Cheat Sheet

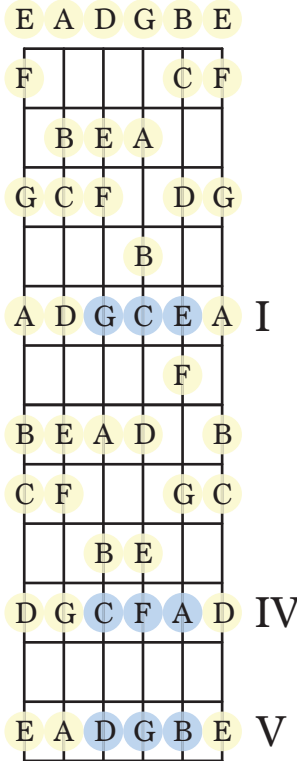
Playing chords with a slide is tricky because you can only play them if each chord tone is on the same fret.

In standard EADGBE tuning, you're stuck with a set of triads like the ones shown to the right, in the key of C Major:

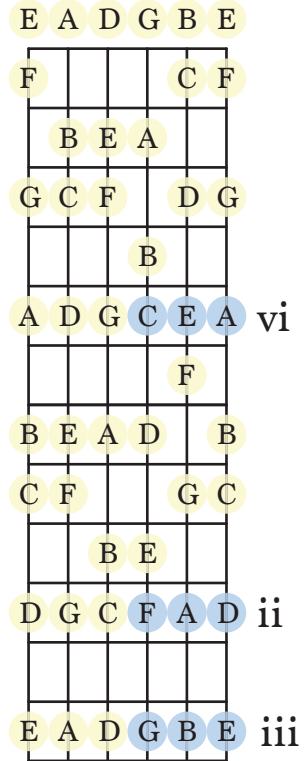
## Triads in C Major

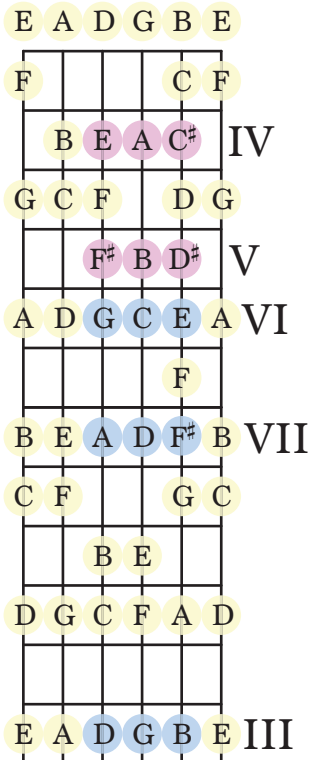
### Major Triads



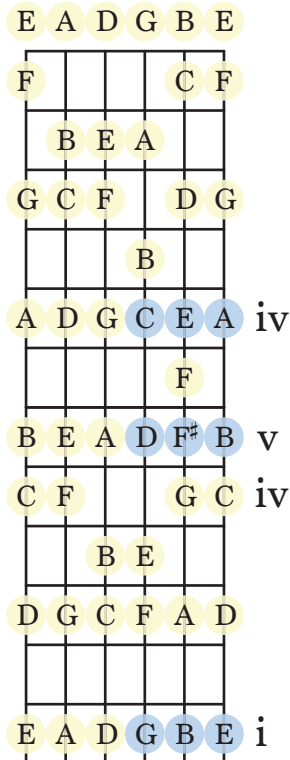
### Minor Triads
