# DRAWING A STYLIZED PORTRAIT IN PROCREATE

#### **TOOLS**

#### > IPAD PRO & PROCREATE

I used the iPad pro 2022 and Procreate 5.35, but I think any version would work fine for this workflow.

#### > GOUACHE MAXPACK

This is my preferred brush set, but you can use any brush you like, as long as it has some texture to it.

#### **KEY LESSONS**

- How to analyze and break down your reference image.
- How to keep your sketch simple, using stylized proportions.
- How to layer colors for a painterly and textured effect.

#### **TIPS**

#### **CHOOSE REF THAT CATCHES YOUR EYE**

This gives you something you can lean into when you stylize and exaggerate your drawing.

#### **FOCUS ON THE FIRST STEPS**

It's easiest to get a stylized effect when you exaggerate the shapes in your initial sketch.

# **CHOOSE REF THAT SHOWS 3-DIMENSIONALITY**

If you understand the volumes of the face you're drawing, then it's a lot easier to stylize it.

# **DEMO // STEPS**

#### 01 // CREATING A SKETCH | TIMECODE: 06:30

- Draw a few loose sketches at a small size, using stylized proportions.
- Choose the one that works best and scale it up. Draw a slightly more detailed sketch on top.

#### 02 // ADDING COLOR | TIMECODE: 11:07

- VARIATION 01 // clean colors
  - Block in one color as the silhouette.
  - Then use the lasso tool to select other areas one by one, adjusting them to bring in additional colors.
- VARIATION 02 // messy base colors
  - Flood fill the layer. Paint some messy colors with a big textured brush underneath.
  - Block in a background color on a new layer on top.
- Finish with a multiply layer to block in some quick shadows.

#### 03 // SCULPTING THE DETAILS | TIMECODE: 18:55

- Merge all of the layers and start refining the details.
- Gradually bring in darker and lighter colors to bring more definition to your portrait.

# 04 // DETAILING & FINALIZING | TIMECODE: 15:10

- Choose a focal point and start in this area.
- Add an extra pass of clean, fine detail with high contrast to this area.
- Move out from there, making sure not to overwhelm or distract from the focal point.
