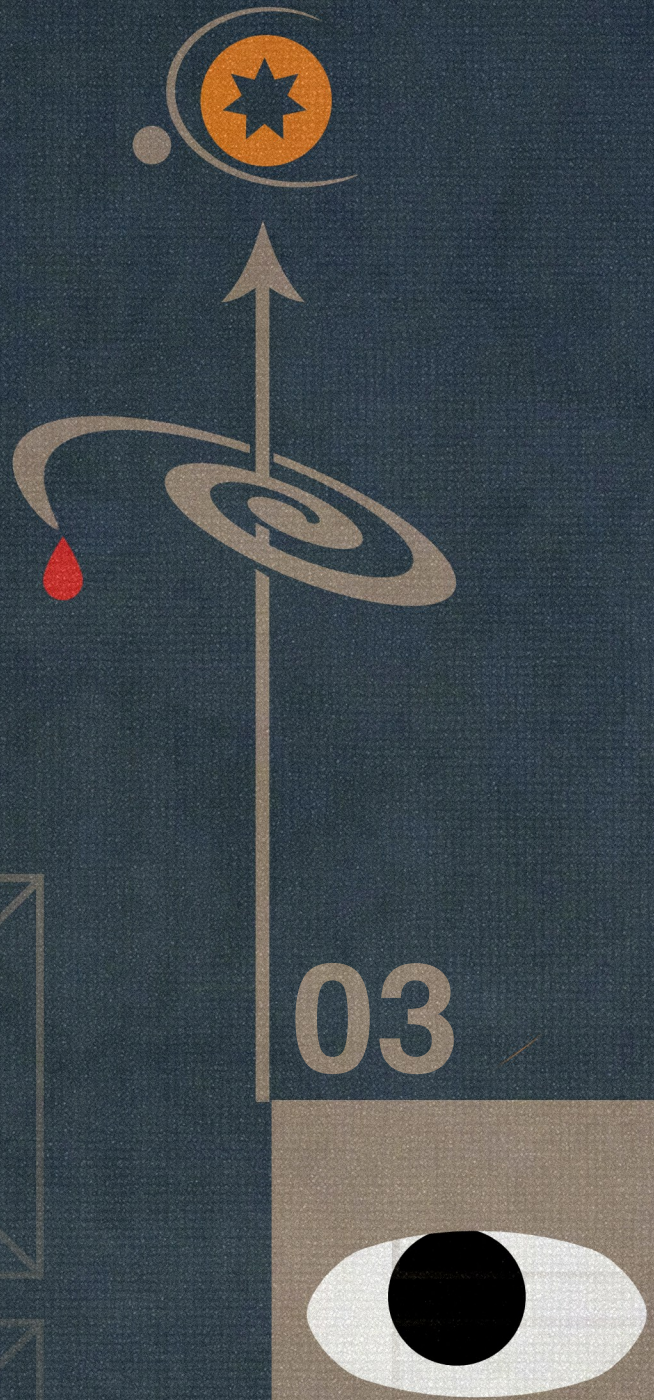
WELCOME


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What is LIMINA?

“Tasked with”? Who tasked you?

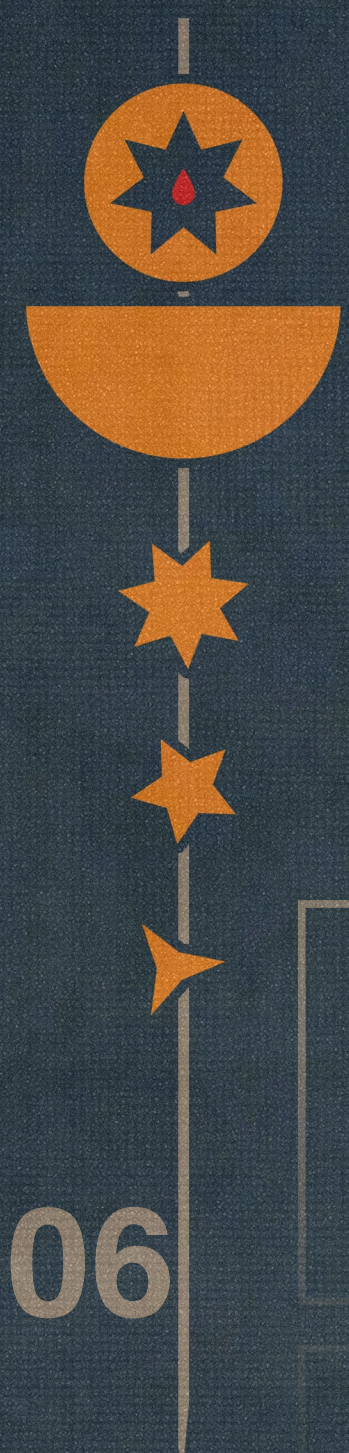

But... why? What do you get out of this?

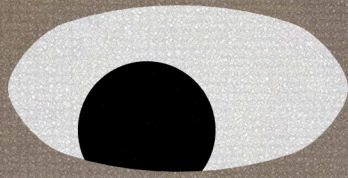

- A top-down map of the borough
- Thorough dissections of each borough’s political, cultural, economic, military, and religious institutions
- Well-researched profiles detailing significant community members that a courier may end up encountering during deliveries
- Briefings on theorized upcoming events, cataclysms, opportunities, and otherwise consequential scenarios
- Tailor-made music to help acclimate couriers to the culture and atmosphere of each borough

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Using LIMINA's Guides

The worst thing that could happen would be if one of these guides were to fall into the hands of some enterprising adventurers. It would be quite improper if a party of 3 to 5 brave travelers were to gaze upon the contents found within. Our guides are specifically designed for those who know what to do with its contents: our General Messengers (hereafter referred to as "GMs").

LIMINA's guides are not designed to tell our multifaceted GMs exactly what to do. Rather, they provide a set of useful information and tools that may help you to plan your own delivery campaigns. With the details provided in our guides, any GM should have all the facts they need to travel to, explore, and (if need be) temporarily inhabit each unique borough.

Using LIMINA's Guides

Here at **LIMINA**, we take great pains to recruit couriers who use wildly different means and methods, and sometimes couriers who seem to operate under different sets of rules altogether. We strive to make sure our guides are universally useful for couriers, regardless of how our GMs actually make their deliveries. As such the guide to each borough makes no assumptions about what sort of couriers may be involved in the delivery, nor any assumption about the framework they use to conceive of and interact with the multiverse.

Throughout **LIMINA**'s fabled history of exploring the multiverse, one fact has remained ever true: no matter how different two boroughs may seem, an aspect of one may show up instead in another. Despite how improbable it sounds, GMs will often submit reports that include persons from one borough manifesting somewhere else, entire buildings seemingly copied and pasted into another dimension, or rumors of exploits repeating themselves in lands with nothing else in common. We trust our GMs to make decisions for themselves, and we find no issue with these reports. Whether they're simply making up tales of their own, or somehow altering the universe by their very existence, GMs should not worry about introducing foreign elements borrowed from one borough and placed elsewhere. Ultimately, **LIMINA** simply provides the packages and offers the guides: what actually happens in a given borough is up to the GM.



What to Expect

In the months and years to come,³ bold recruits who choose to partner with **LIMINA** should expect a wide variety of assignments. With every new borough explored, our couriers further experience the breadth of possibilities that the multiverse can offer to intrepid voyagers. While GMs are free to make their deliveries however they see fit, it is overwhelmingly likely that each will meet bizarre and intriguing residents and travelers, navigate complex socio-political conflicts, confront treacherous beasts, disrupt local economies and ecosystems, and explore glorious and bizarre locales to a fitting omnipresent soundtrack.
