

They say "knowledge is power" and nowhere is that more true than in the world of music. Since starting your lessons, you have learned a ton about the way music works. Each lesson has put you one step closer toward being an expert musician. Let's put our knowledge to the test!

1) Name the Parts of the Guitar



Three Main Sections:

- A) The **Body** is hollow, allowing the sound to be amplified!
- B) The Neck has frets that allow me to shorten the strings, and change the tones!
- C) The <u>Head Stock</u> has tuners attached so I can adjust the tightness of my strings, which changes the pitch!

Smaller parts:

- 1) The **Bridge** attaches the strings to the "body"
- 2) The <u>Saddle</u> keeps the strings in position.
- 3) The <u>Sound-Hole</u> amplifies the sound of my guitar.
- 4) The <u>Fretboard</u> is the main playing area, where my fingers move very fast!
- 5) The metal <u>Frets</u> are used to create notes, by shortening the strings.
- 6) The <u>Nut</u>also keeps the strings in position, much like the saddle!
- 7) The <u>Tuners, or Machine Heads</u> are used to tighten and loosen the strings, to change pitches.


