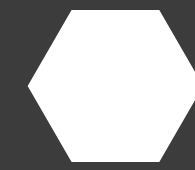

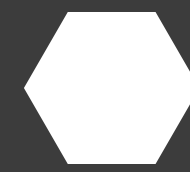

I'm starting from a black primed base here, painting the gun first.



Paint in the plasma coils with White. Thin it down 50/50 with water. You might need to apply two to three layers for a solid coverage.



Paint the plasma coils with pure Emerald thinned to a layer consistency.



Glaze pure Emerald around the coils and areas where the light would hit for the glow.



Mix Emerald and White 2:1 and thin down with water to a layer consistency. Then apply to the lower part of the coils.



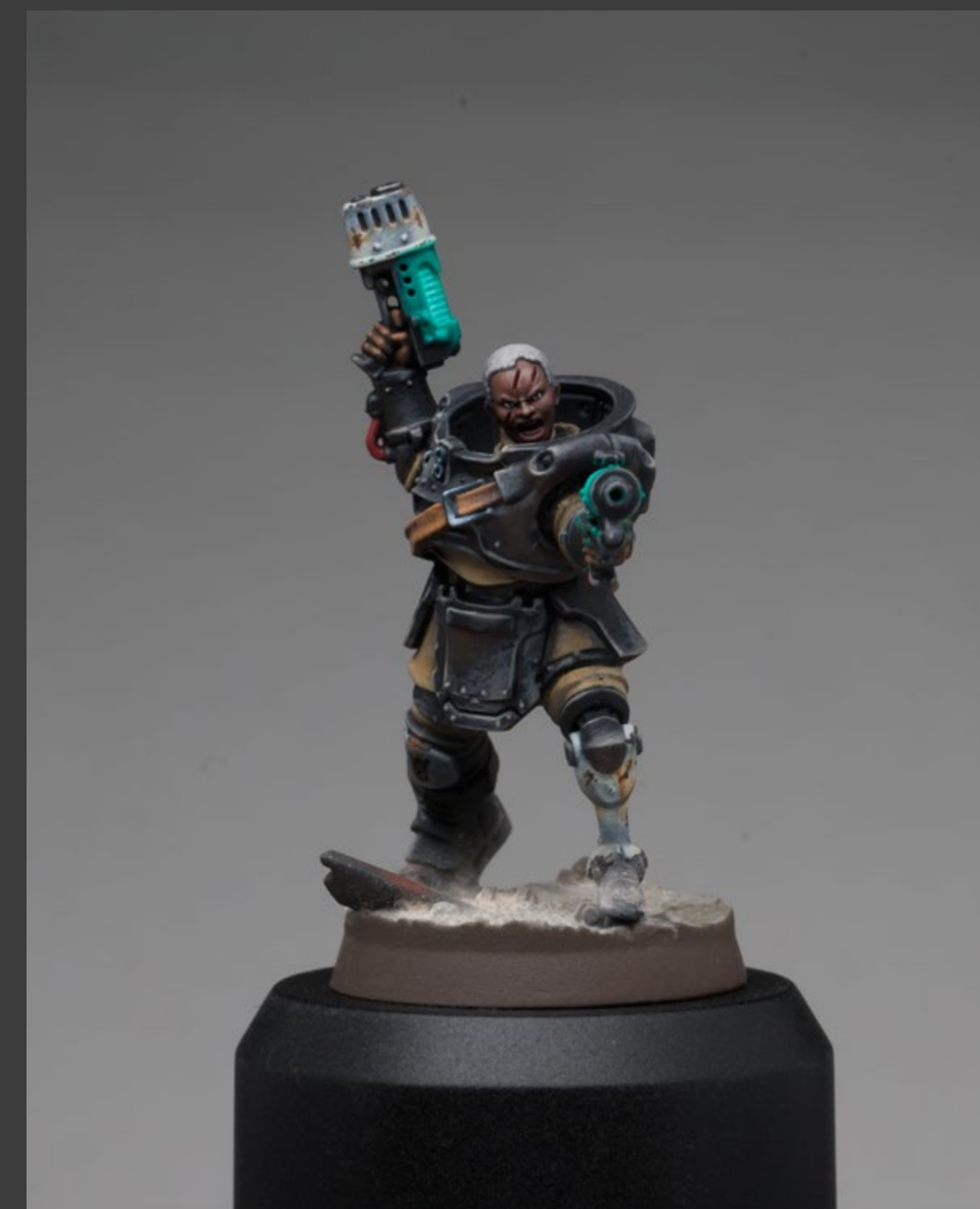
Mix Emerald and White 1:1 and thin down with water to a layer consistency. Then apply to the lower part of the coils covering a smaller area than before.



Apply the 1:1 mix as a glaze around the coils to increase brightness off the osl.



Apply a small amount of pure White to the lowest part of the coils.
