



D12 CAVES AND THEIR CONTENTS

SCROLL OF REVELATION #107

[1. Dragon's Maw] You've made a terrible mistake. This isn't a cave. It's the open jaws of a sun-bathing desert dragon. **[2. Werebear Den]** Etched into the walls are the introspective thoughts of a farmer who seals themselves inside this cave on full moons to keep them from hurting anyone. **[3. Cursed Flute]** The cave mouth resembles a screaming devil's face with dozens of curling, flute-shaped horns. Sealed within is a blood-drenched flute carved from a paladin's rib bone. **[4. Stone Gnomes]** The rooftops of a forgotten gnomish town act as stairs down this steep jungle cave. Many of the homes still have petrified gnomes huddled together inside them. **[5. Teleportation Circle]** Only those who speak the language of the old druids have any hope of figuring out where it might lead. **[6. Cult Altar]** Carved into a massive crystal in the center of the cave that is stained with the blood of 100 tieflings sacrificed here by a zealous, angel-worshipping cult. **[7. Mad Mage]** Cradling themselves at the back of the cave is a manic sorcerer who went insane after they accidentally killed their entire family when they discovered their powers. **[8. Blood]** A babbling brook of blood trickles out of the cave mouth, originating from the corpse of a vampire hunter pinned to the wall with a wooden stake. **[9. Magic Crystals]** Clinging to the ceiling are 1d6 incredibly fragile crystals that, if properly removed, can store spells within them that are released when the crystal breaks. **[10. Hibernating]** Sleeping in the darkest corner is a grizzly drake in its final week of winter hibernation. **[11. Cave Art]** This crude yet beautiful cave art was drawn by the first elves and seems to show a mountain-sized monster being trapped beneath the forest. **[12. Hourglass]** What feels like only an hour watching the sands fall through the glass while inside this cave is actually 10 years of time passing outside of the cave.
