Actions

Rage. (3/day) Reckless Attack. Danger Sense. Shield Master. Multiattack.

Spear. Melee or Ranged Weapon Attack +5 to hit, range 30/120ft, one target. Hit: 8 (1d6 +5) piercing damage.

Ancestral Protectors. Spectral warriors appear she is enraged. While enraged, the first creature she hits with an attack on her turn becomes the target of the warriors. Until the start of her next turn, that target has disadvantage on any attack roll that isn't against her, and when the target hits a creature other than her with an attack, that creature has resistance to the damage type of the target's attacks.

TRAITS AND MANNERISMS

"I will have my vengeance and bring peace to the spirits of my people." ~ Rhada Stonespear

Ideal. The driving force behind Rhada is her passion for combat and her goal to find the demon who destroyed her tribe.

Flaw. While she tells the tale of how a demon killed her entire clan, she hides her immense shame that the demon possessed her in order to do so.

Speech. A lovely alto who sometimes comically misuses a word in her accented common.

Personality. Cheerful and optimistic and is a faithful companion; Rhada hides the pain of her past well.

APPEARANCE

Rhada is a 6'2" tall, well-muscled, and battle-scarred warrior with long braided blond hair and piercing emerald green eyes. Intricate blue woad tattoos cover her arms, telling the story of her lost tribe.

BACKSTORY

Born amongst a tribe of the the wild plains, Rhada gained great renown as a fierce warrior of her people. She was known for singing battle hymns while leading the charge during combat, her voice as radiant as her spear was deadly. Her life was changed the day tribe raided a caravan that had entered their territory. Upon opening a rune and gem encrusted chest that was amongst the spoils, Rhada was possessed by a demonic spirit that had been trapped inside. Now a prisoner in her own body, Rhada could only watch with horror, screaming silently in her mind as the demon used her to slaughter every member of her tribe before blacking out.
